Scholarship Details:

- > The amount of each scholarship shall be no less than \$1,000.00, amount to be determined by vote and discretion of the PWB Executive Board.
- Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the educational institution provided. The check will be made out jointly to the recipient and educational institution (if applicable). The scholarship is not redeemable for cash and is non-transferable.
- > The PWB will honor the Scholarship award recipient(s) at the Home Builders Association (HBA) Awards of Excellence Event (Details TBD). Recipient(s) will be recognized in person at the event, or by video if they are unable to attend.

Eligibility:

- > Scholarship is open to Women Professionals.
- > Must reside in Michigan and be a U.S Citizen.
- Must be enrolled at an approved college, university, or accredited institution for vocational training and pursuing a degree or certification in a course of study directly related to the construction industry (Examples include but are not limited to Construction Management, Architecture, Carpentry, Interior Design, Landscape Architecture, Welding, etc.)
- > Must have completed a minimum of 1 year in their current program.

Requirements:

- Applications are due by April 5, 2024.
- > Applicants must submit the completed application.
- Write a brief statement / essay consisting of a 1–2-page paper typed, double spaced, using
- 12-point font.
 - Essay Topic: What inspired you to get involved in the construction industry, and what are your future goals after completing your specified degree or program?
 - Additional details you may include if desired:
 - Tell us about your goals and how this scholarship would help advance you to achieve these desired goals.
 - Describe why you should be selected to receive this award.
- > Include two letters of recommendation from a current or past instructor, employer, or personal reference (non-relative).
- > Include your High School and/or College transcript with your application.
- Applications including all the above requirements must be received by the
 Professional Women in Building Council <u>no later than April 15 if they are mailed.</u>
- Recipients will be notified if they are receiving the award by a phone call and email the week of April 29.

Obligations of the Scholarship Recipient:

- Conduct self in a manner that does not discredit the school, the employer, or the building industry
- If the Recipient is unable to attend the Awards Ceremony, we will need a video sent to the PWB Executive board regarding what this scholarship means to you. You may read or describe what you have written in your essay or add any other pertinent information you would like.
- Additionally, we would like to follow up with you, a year after you receive your scholarship to check in and see how beneficial the scholarship was. This will most likely occur by email / phone call and we would love for you to respond so we can better serve additional recipients just like yourself.
